I would also like to announce that Ana Nowland has volunteered to join our Secretariat. She will be taking over as Treasurer for the Cursillo community.

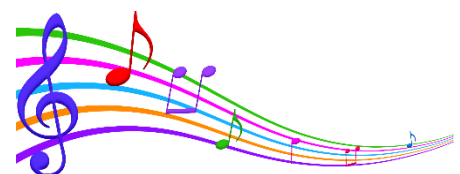
If you would like to serve on the Secretariat, please contact any member on the Secretariat.
